Table officials are responsible for ensuring a professional and accurate level of scorekeeping, stats and game clock management. Members of this team may be cross-trained to learn more than one position. These positions will typically work a minimum of 10 hours each week but may require more as the season schedule dictates. Basketball: Timekeeper

Description: Work with our team of Basketball Table Officials to provide accurate in arena statistics and timing. This positions includes controlling the basketball score clock, game clock and shot clock.

Basketball: Statistician

Description: Work with our Basketball Stats Team to accurately track the games statistics. These positions include stat entry (logging stats for online viewing and Stat Call (dictating to the stat entry position for easier entry

Hockey: Statistician

Description: Work with our Hockey Penalty Box Team to accurately track the games statistics. Log these statistics on the e-scoresheet for fans and coaches monitoring the games online.

Volleyball: Statistician

Description: Work with our Volleyball statistics team to accurately track the games statistics. These positions include stat entry (logging stats for online viewing, Stat Call (dictating to the stat entry position for easier entry and scribe (manually logging all plays to ensure noting is missed).
